

Simon Says ... Represent the County



- Counties where CDA is statutorily assigned to represent county:
 - Austin (sort of), Bexar, Brazoria, Calhoun, Cass, Comal (CC), Denton, Galveston, Harrison, Jefferson, Kendall, Panola (sort of), Randall, Smith, Tarrant, Upshur, Victoria, Walker
- County where CA is statutorily assigned to represent county:
 - El Paso, Fort Bend, Grimes, Harris, Matagorda, Wharton

Who Else Is in the Rolodex?



♦ TEX. CONST. art. V, § 21

- * "The County Attorneys shall represent the State in all cases in the District and inferior courts in their respective counties; but if any county shall be included in a district in which there shall be a District Attorney, the respective duties of District Attorneys and County Attorneys shall in such counties be regulated by the Legislature."
- Duty defined by statute
 - No independent power to bring suit

What If We're Not on the List?



- ♦ General Rule: No civil requirement
- ♦ Says Who?
 - ♦ SCOTex, that's who
- County may contract
 - ♦ Beware of chapter 46, Gov't Code

Let Your Assets Work for You

- ♦ Section 157.901, Local Gov't Code
 - NOTE: criminal charges or conflict may require outside counsel
- Section 41.007, Gov't Code
- ♦ Get to know CA/DA
- **♦ Notice**
- Notify insurers IMMEDIATELY




Put It Where You Can Find It (And Know Where That Is)



- ♦ Centralize, centralize, centralize
- Plan for what you'll need
 - **⋄** Insurance policies
 - ♦ Involved official/employee list
 - **♦ EVERY document**
 - **⋄** Policies, regulations, contracts
 - ♦ Photographs/videos
 - Accident reports/witness statements
