2001: The Texas Legislature created the Texas Task Force on Indigent Defense

2011: Texas Indigent Defense Commission (TIDC)

HB 1318 - by the 83rd Legislature amended Gov Code section 79.036 required counties to breakdown data by attorney.

SB 560 - by the 86th Legislature added expenditures and appointment data regarding CPS cases.

SB 380 – by the 88th Legislature added appointment data regarding Interpreters.



Social Work – work carried out by trained personnel with the aim of alleviating the conditions of those in need of help or welfare

Expert Witness – money paid by the county or managed assigned counsel program to a person/entity qualified by the court or by special certifications in a field of study or expertise to provide assistance to a licensed attorney in preparing or presenting a defense for a party in a suit affecting the parent-child relationship or suit requesting a parent be ordered to complete services filed by the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services

Investigator – money paid by the county or managed assigned counsel program to a person licensed as an investigator or otherwise legally able to conduct investigations for a licensed attorney in preparing a defense for a party in a suit affecting the parent-child relationship or suit requesting a parent be ordered to complete services filed by the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services

Other Litigation — money paid by the county or managed assigned counsel program to a person or entity for materials, supplies, or services determined by the attorney or court necessary for the licensed attorney to prepare an adequate defense for a party in a suit affecting the parent-child relationship or suit requesting a parent be ordered to complete services filed by the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services

WHEN SHOULD AN INTERPRETER BE INCLUDED?

- Interpreters on staff report salary and fringe
- Interpreters paid by the day that are assigned a court
- Interpreters that come to the jail if they are on staff or contracted by the county
- Interpreters provided free of charge, irrespective of ability to pay in criminal or juvenile cases
- Interpreters who provided services in criminal, civil, or juvenile cases prior to a court appearance in front of a judge
- Interpretation services provided even if the case never makes it to trial

INTERPRETER REPORTING: FY 2024

SB 380/HB 3474 (88TH LEGISLATURE)

Data should only include matters held at the <u>district and county</u> <u>court</u> levels.

Data to be reported on the TIDC IDER.

The first year of data will cover October 1, 2023 – September 30, 2024, and is due by November 1, 2024.
