

#### PLAINTIFFS' ORIGINAL COMPLAINT

Jesus Torres was beaten, stabbed, and strangled by a group of El Paso County jail detainees, and he ultimately died. El Paso County's policies, practices, and/or customs were moving forces behind Mr. Torres' suffering and death.
